The Ohel David Synagogue / Monument of Pune / Lal Davel (Red Synagogue) 9 Dr. Ambedkar Road, Pune


Built between 1863 – 1867 by David Sassoon, whose mausoleum is in the precincts of the synagogue. There is a Mikvah in the compound that is not in operation.

The maintenance is done through the Sassoon Trust Fund.

Services today are conducted by the Bnei Israel community.









